Lectures

Theme: Lectures on the operation and organization of transport systems (1-2 week/topic).

Seminars

No. of classes: One (90 min) / week – Wednesday 8:30 am

Theme: 4 on-field traffic measurements
(1 class for presentation, 1 for measurement itself for each)
2 in-class exercises (1 class for both)
